

RNIP Employer Eligibility Attestation

Employers must complete the following attestation for **each** candidate to which they have provided an offer of employment with the purpose of supporting a candidate's application to the Sudbury Rural and Northern Immigration Program.

In order to be designated to participate in the Pilot in Sudbury, the employer must:	Employer Initial
Be located within the boundaries of Sudbury, defined as the census metropolitan area of Greater Sudbury in Ontario, as defined by Statistics Canada.	
Have active operations in Sudbury for a minimum of one (1) year.	
Have no outstanding orders made against them under the Ontario Employment Standards Act, 2000 or the Occupational Health and Safety Act.	
Not be in violation of the Immigration, Refugee and Protection Act (IRPA) or Immigration, Refugee and Protection Regulations.	
Provide a genuine job offer in an eligible occupation co-signed by the candidate that meets the requirements of the Ministerial Instructions.	
Demonstrate that they are confident that the individual is reasonably able to carry out the functions of the job offer, as demonstrated by past work experience, interviews and reference checks completed by the employer.	
Acknowledge that they did not receive any form of payment in exchange for the job offer.	
Confirm that Canadians and Permanent Residents have been considered first to fill the job	

Please note that any misrepresentation of information will result in your company's ineligibility to participate in the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot Program.
